Always remember that you represent Sunshine Academy, which delivers unconditional love, care, and respect. As part of our ongoing commitment to excellence, I agree to observe and abide by the following requirements:

- 1. Be prepared to teach, create your lesson in advance. The Sunshine Academy Director will audit classes and give feedback as necessary.
- 2. Center staff will always be in the classroom and will be responsible for the children, volunteers should not be alone with the children.
- 3. Do not visit other parts of the Center, stay at Sunshine Academy.
- 4. Always put the children's welfare as the number one priority.
- 5. Agree to provide the necessary documents, including: passport/ID card, resume, health certificate (including proof of hepatitis A and B vaccinations), immunizations, background/reference check and two passport size photos.
- 6. Respect and protect the privacy of each child at the Social Welfare Center.
- 7. Absolutely no picture taking or photography of any kind.
- 8. Do not bring gifts or food to the children.
- 9. Do not bring any guests or visitors without prior approval from the Sunshine Academy Director.
- 10. Report any incidents to the Center staff immediately and then to the Sunshine Academy Director as soon as possible.
- 11. Attend and participate in all required training sessions.
- 12. Without approval, no individual or group can organize or arrange any activity in the name of Sunshine Academy or the Social Welfare Center.
- 13. Do not engage in any external communication (media reports, etc.).
- 14. No discussions on subjects such adoption or foster care with the Social Welfare Center staff.
- 15. Refrain from sharing personal beliefs or world view with the children or with the Social Welfare Center staff.
- 16. Refrain from inviting the Social Welfare Center staff to your home or other outside social events.
- 17. Consistently carry out the designated activities with integrity and in the spirit in which the Sunshine Academy was created.
